PREFACE

Recognizing the fact that Kentucky is a key state in an historical and genealogical sense, and responding to a growing desire that, during her administration, something constructive be done about Kentucky records, Mrs. Fred Osborne, State Regent, Kentucky Society, Daughters of the American Revolution, appointed the Kentucky Records Research Committee to appraise the content and condition of these records, to make recommendations, and to take action as required. At its first meeting, in June 1959, the committee, whose eight members represent various phases of D. A. R. work, decided to "take action" by compiling and indexing for publication, cemetery and Bible records taken from carbon copies of reports made through the years to the Genealogical Records Chairmen. The original reports were deposited in the D. A. R. Library, National Headquarters, Washington, D. C.; carbon copies were deposited in the John Fox, Jr., Library, Duncan Tavern Historic Center, State Headquarters and Shrine, Paris, Kentucky. We are proud to present this, the first in a proposed series of volumes of cemetery and Bible records. Net proceeds from the sale of these books will be used for the development of the Historic Center.

No original research has been done. This is a compilation of records reported by the chapters of the Kentucky Society, D. A. R., and represents a half-century of "labors of love" by Kentucky Daughters. Due to weather, neglect and vandalism, many old cemeteries have already disappeared; thus it was with the idea of preserving the records of those which remain, that the Daughters of the American Revolution have been copying inscriptions all these years. It is ardently hoped that the publication of this book will stimulate others to preserve old cemeteries and their records before it is too late. This Committee will be very glad to receive unpublished Kentucky records from any who want them preserved for the future and made available to researchers by wider distribution in the present.

I like that ancient Saxon phrase, which calls
The burial ground "God's Acre." It is just;
It consecrates each grave within its walls,
And breathes a benison o'er the sleeping dust.

These words by Longfellow might well be adopted as a watchword by the D. A. R., for one of the aims of this Society is the preservation of historic spots. What spots are more historic than the resting-places of our forefathers?

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS
